

Circumcision at Gilgal – a circle/a wheel

Joshua 5:9 And the Lord said unto Joshua, This day have I *rolled (galal)* away the reproach of Egypt from off you. Wherefore the name of the place is called Gilgal unto this day.

The Significance of Gilgal

Priest/Warrior

- Joshua 5:5 Circumcision Prior to Promised Land
Joshua 10:15 Continuing Camp of Military Operations
Judges 2:1 Angel of the Lord Encamped Therein

Prophet

- I Samuel 7:16 A third of Samuel's Circuit of Ministry
II Kings 2:1, 2 A residence of Elijah and Elisha

King

- I Samuel 11:14 Saul conferred as King
I Samuel 15:23 Kingship taken from Saul
II Samuel 19:15,16 Welcome place of David after Absalom defeated

galal – rolling, or to encircle

Trust and Commitment for a Completion of Purpose

Psalm 22:8 He *trusted* on the Lord that he would deliver him: let him deliver him, seeing he delighted in him. (this passage was quoted by Jesus during darkness on the Cross)

Psalm 37:5 *Commit* thy way unto the Lord; trust also in him; and he shall bring it to pass.

Proverbs 16:3 *Commit* thy works unto the Lord, and thy thoughts shall be established.

Day of the Lord

Amos 5:24 But let judgment *run* down as waters, and righteousness as a mighty stream.

Destruction of Babylon

Jeremiah 51:24-25 And I will render unto Babylon and to all the inhabitants of Chaldea all their evil that they have done in Zion in your sight, saith the Lord. [25] Behold, I am against thee, O destroying mountain, saith the Lord, which destroyest all the earth: and I will stretch out mine hand upon thee, and *roll* thee down from the rocks, and will make thee a burnt mountain.

Every Warfare Encounter

Isaiah 9:5 For every battle of the warrior is with confused noise, and garments *rolled* in blood; but this shall be with burning and fuel of fire.

Fulfillment of Prophetic Mandate

Isaiah 34:4 And all the host of heaven shall be dissolved, and the heavens shall be *rolled* together as a scroll: and all their host shall fall down, as the leaf falleth off from the vine, and as a falling fig from the fig tree.

galgal- a wheel, a whirlwind of dust

Gathering of Thunder

Psalms 77:18 The voice of thy thunder was in the *heaven*: the lightnings lightened the world: the earth trembled and shook.

Ecclesiastes 12:6 Or ever the silver cord be loosed, or the golden bowl be broken, or the pitcher be broken at the fountain, or the *wheel* broken at the cistern.

Warfare

Psalms 83:13 O my God, make them like a *wheel*; as the stubble before the wind.

Isaiah 5:28 Whose arrows are sharp, and all their bows bent, their horses' hoofs shall be counted like flint, and their *wheels* like a whirlwind:

Isaiah 17:13 The nations shall rush like the rushing of many waters: but God shall rebuke them, and they shall flee far off, and shall be chased as the chaff of the mountains before the wind, and like a *rolling* thing before the whirlwind.

Ministering With the Cherubs

Ezekiel 10:2 And he spake unto the man clothed with linen, and said, Go in between the *wheels*, even under the cherub, and fill thine hand with coals of fire from between the cherubims, and scatter them over the city. And he went in in my sight.

Ezekiel 10:6 And it came to pass, that when he had commanded the man clothed with linen, saying, Take fire from between the *wheels*, from between the cherubims; then he went in, and stood beside the wheels.

Ezekiel 10:13 As for the wheels, it was cried unto them in my hearing, O *wheel*.
